#### Investor pitching

In order to secure dynamic growth of start-ups and scale-ups, entrepreneurs get the unique chance to pitch to renowned international investors who are willing to drive entrepreneurial success to the next level through potential investments, expertise, network, advice and mentoring.

### Corporate challenge

This novel format offers a tailored and life science specific matchmaking between large companies and start-ups. The topics for the challenge will be defined by corporates - both, topics and application forms, will be available very soon. If you are a start-up with a technological solution addressing the topic, don't hesitate to apply! It will give you the chance to pitch in front of the corporate and to be part of the upcoming HTH event. The best start-ups will be awarded and will have the chance to be on stage!

### International collaborative projects

In this session, consortia of large projects have the opportunity to present themselves and to gather recommendations for existing problems from a panel of experts representing different areas.
